TO CHANGE BATTERY PACK:

After your warranty has expired, a battery pack can be changed at home. (When the receiver is under warranty, we change the battery at our facility, and then charge it, retune and recalibrate to insure quality performance.)

The battery is located in the upper back, thicker half of receiver.

INSTRUCTIONS: *PLEASE READ BEFORE ACTING*

1) Look at the receiver's faceplate. On <u>each</u> side of receiver's thicker upper section, remove <u>2</u> screws (total of 4 screws). A Phillips screwdriver is needed.

MOVE SLOWLY and GRADUALLY.

2) Lift the case's top section off. Place this top section on a flat surface so that you can see the battery pack in a metal holder. (DO NOT TOUCH circuitry in bottom half of receiver).

3) The battery holder will need to be loosened to get the old battery pack out. Use screwdriver to loosen screws on <u>outside top</u> of receiver.

4) Note the 2 cables coming from battery pack. They are held together by black tubing. Cut ONLY this <u>black tubing</u> away. This keeps wires together, so the battery pack can be put into case without pinching wires.

5) Unplug ONLY the <u>bigger</u> plastic Molex connector of old battery pack. Remove old battery.

6) Insert new battery. Plug in the Molex connector of new battery pack, fit it into battery holder and tighten down the two battery holder screws. Make sure wires are not crimped.

7) If you want to prevent rattling, you can tape the two cables together <u>where the black</u> <u>tubing had been</u>. This is not mandatory.

8) Fit top section of case to the bottom section. Make sure the two sections are aligned, with corners smooth and screw holes matched. Tighten the two screws on each side of the case's top section.

9) CHARGE BATTERY FOR 16 TO 24 HOURS.

10) Test receiver. Hopefully it will not need to be retuned or recalibrated.

WARNING: Batteries installed incorrectly can cause wiring to burn up and/or batteries to explode. Be sure wires are not crimped when you put the unit back together.
